# Primary instruments for blood cell morphology





### 1. Blood samples mixing

#### V-Mixer

- Used for mixing blood and other samples in closed tubes
- Thorough mixing is achieved by constant spinning
- Gentle mixing prevents damaging of blood cells due to the absence of shaking
- Decrease of workload for laboratory personnel
- Standardized sample preparation



## 2. Blood smear preparation

#### V-Sampler

- High quality blood smears
- Simultaneous preparation of 2 smears
- Setting of thickness and size of the smear
- Compact and lightweight
- Simple and easy to use



# 3. Blood smear staining

#### V-Chromer

- Standardization of microscopic sample staining
- Manual stainer with 6 staining containers
- Use reagents of various manufacturers
- Autoclavable
- Resistant to chemical substances and stains
- Only 80 ml of reagent is used per container
- Reagents are protected from evaporation due to caps on containers and sample holders



## 4. Blood cell microscopy


#### MX 50 Binocular microscope
